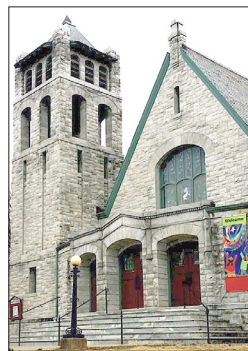

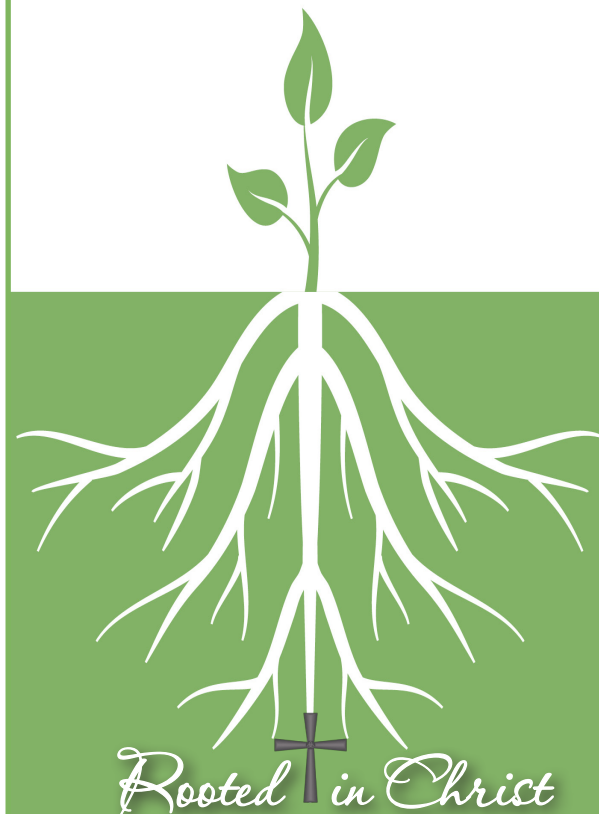

Sunday School 9-9:55am Pre-K through Adult

Classes for Children

-> PreK - Grade 5

-> September-June

Worship Team Bible Study

Sunday Worship 10am

The only time the church community meets all together (children & youth, with young, middle, and older adults), this important and vital part of our growing



faith is where we experience group worship with songs and hymns, led by organ or worship team; Scriptures read responsively or by a lay reader; opportunities to give to our church ministries and other missions locally and globally; praying for prayer requests and the Lord's Prayer; communion on first and third Sundays; Pastor Stephanie Allen preaching truths

from scripture and helping us to see how to apply them to our lives today; a short time of silence and contemplation. Following each service the deacons and pastor are available for prayer and 'anointing with oil' (a Biblical call) for healing.

Nursery During Worship Ages 0-5

A safe, positive, developmentally appropriate church experience for children ages 0-5 years during the worship service.

Junior Church K - Grade 4

-> Sundays 10:20 (following Worship Songs)

-> Will resume in September

Models and provide understanding about Sunday morning worship service, and allows children to participate in an age appropriate worship time. Children stay up for worship on the 4th Sunday of the month.
